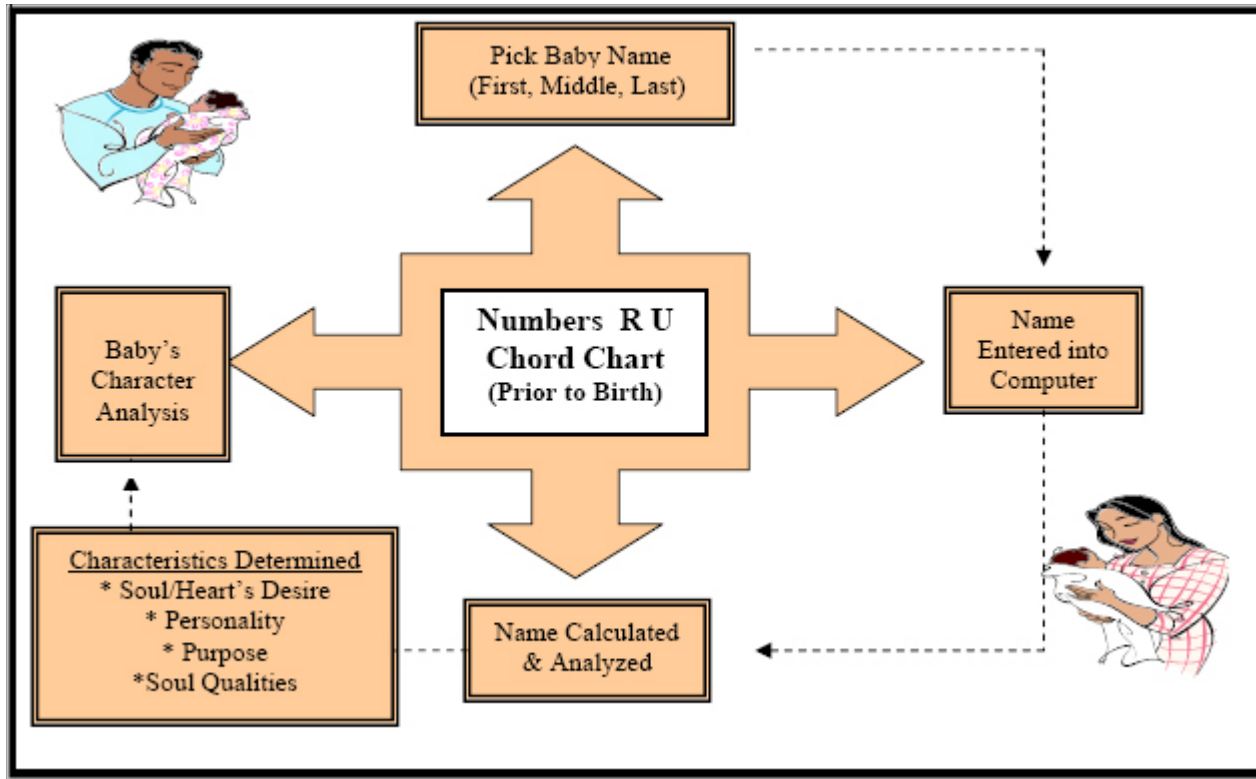

## Introduction

### Baby Naming Analysis

### **Understanding Your Baby's "Core" Characteristics**

Following is a brief written explanation for the meaning of the numbers assigned to each of the characteristics derived from the name researched. In addition, you will find in the back of the chart, a more in-depth Reference Guide for those wanting more details about the full range of characteristics and their meanings from the number combination possibilities that exist, should you decide to test other names. You will find three master lists of numbers ranging from 1, 19/1, 2, 11/2, 3, 4, 13/4, 22/4, 5, 14/5, 23/5, 6, 7, 16/7, 8, 9, to 18/9 and sorted by Soul Desire, Personality and Purpose in that order.

### **Your #7 Soul Desire (Also called the Heart's Desire)**

The #7 Soul Desire is for truth, wisdom, and knowledge, an inherent nature for the #7 and a mystical number of completion. ### Understanding Your Baby's Soul Qualities

There are eight Soul Qualities (SQs) and each is assigned a numerical value based on a formula used to calculate the SQs derived from the name researched. These numbers indicate if the particular SQ has already been developed and to what degree or if it is an area that must be developed in order to achieve your highest potential in this lifetime.

**Soul Qualities #1, #3, and #5 will have a normal value of “3” while Soul Qualities #2, #4, #6, #7, and #8 will have a normal value of “1”.**

A Soul Quality assigned a number value with a “Plus” means that the person has been developing this quality and exceeds the normal value indicated. A Soul Quality assigned a number value followed by a “Minus” means the person has not yet reached the particular level of understanding for that Soul Quality and has more work to do in that area in order to achieve balance and full potential.

**Although we have provided you with the full explanation and definitions of what the Soul Qualities mean, they would only apply to knowing in advance of the birth what areas your child will need to develop in based on the name selection.**

### **General Information on Selecting a Chord or Vibration**

What would you say if you were told that you have the power to pick the three top “core” characteristics of your child’s “design” by virtue of a “name” selection process—imagine that! The name you assign to your baby’s Birth Certificate along with the birthdate will determine your child’s foundational blueprint and the experiences he/she will experience throughout their entire lifetime. After all, a name selection is a big decision when you think about it. Choosing the right name for your infant is one of the first and most important things you will ever do for your new baby. Remember, you and your newborn will have to live with the name for the rest of his/her life whether they like the name you have selected or not and it’s how the world will identify your child. The more insight you have into the powerful influence of their name before assigning that name, the greater the opportunity to enjoy the success your child is capable of achieving based on the vibrational patterns inherent in the name you have chosen.

As a parent do you want the ability to influence whether your child grows up to be a lover, leader, business executive, diplomat, lawyer, entrepreneur, entertainer, builder, healer, and teacher or for that matter, what profession your child will ultimately choose for his/her self?

The naming convention influences the vibration assigned to the name of the infant. It has long been recognized throughout time that names play a vital part in directing and influencing one’s destiny. Everything is named and numbered; therefore, Numerology recognizes that a spiritual master plan lay hidden in names and the numbers comprising them. Numerology, the science of numbers, applies numbers to names that determine the experience drawn to that human being coming into the world bearing a particular name or you might say that Numerology is like a mirror that reflects your life’s journey in the form of numbers.

Here’s how the process works. Your name and birthdate together form your “foundational” blueprint (Basic Numerology chart) that you are born with which remains with you your entire life or until you legally change your name - at which time, certain characteristics are then altered from the foundational blueprint by virtue of the name change after a seven-to-nine year period of time.



Because we don't know when the infant will be born we cannot factor the birthdate into the equation yet, so the next best thing we can do is to research just the name by itself. The name reveals the "personal" characteristics of the individual and the Soul Qualities, and by generating the Chord chart (a partial chart prior to birth), we can discover the three primary characteristics and eight Soul Qualities that determine the design or developmental patterns that the infant will grow into.

The three unique characteristics found in the Chord chart are: the Soul/Heart's Desire, Personality, and Purpose and are explained as follows. The Soul Desire reflects the emotional aspect and inner motivations of the heart calling out for you to seek to express yourself. The Personality forms the first real impressions made on the outside world (how people perceive you at first glance), and the Purpose which reveals the person's mission in life; specifically, it is what you must do and be, not what you are or what you may desire to be. Depending on the name selection, there are seventeen number combination possibilities for each characteristic or a total of fifty-one ways to mix and match choosing the three characteristics.

After the birth, we can generate a Basic Numerology chart to determine the blueprint or destiny your child will experience in this lifetime that includes all of the nine characteristics. Knowing this information will allow you to have a much better understanding of your child's characteristics, how they are designed, so to speak, and enable you to work with your child based on knowing what his/her characteristics are. This character analysis gives you more insight into your child's behavioral patterns so you can influence your child in a more positive way during the most important stages of their life.

Depending on whether you want to name your infant before or after birth, Numbers R U can offer you both types of Little One Baby Naming charts as shown below and on the following page.

#### Chord Chart

If the baby has not yet been born, the Chord Chart would be generated providing the "3" core characteristics of the baby's name and "8" development soul qualities until birth, then a Basic Chart could be run.

#### Basic Numerology Chart

After the birth, the Basic chart would be generated calculating the baby's Birthname and Birthdate together to provide the full foundational blueprint of the baby's name.

As parents, you have the ability to select the core characteristics of your child by merely selecting a name that calculates to be the Chord or vibration of the characteristics you desire. Discover how the name you select will affect your infant's Soul/Heart's Desire, Personality, and Purpose and how you can research a name until you choose a name you love with having a thorough understanding of what that name truly means to the life of your child.

It is highly recommended that sometime after the birth and before your child enters Kindergarten, that you order the Basic chart and a reading/consultation so you can learn what his/her foundational blueprint will reveal, that will include your child's destiny, all of the characteristics, vibrational growth cycles and challenges, pinnacles, strengths and weaknesses and soul lessons for their lifetime. You will be leap years ahead of those parents who are not aware that this valuable tool exists in assessing the layout and design of your child's character, strengths and weaknesses.

### Type of Numbers Found in Your Chart

In your chart you will find two different types of numbers; either a single-digit number called a "root" number (e.g. 4, 5, 6, etc.) or a compound number, a series of two numbers followed by a slash and a root number (e.g. 13/4, 23/5, 16/7 etc.). Compound numbers that appear in the chart have a more in-depth meaning as opposed to the root number. Two of the eight most common compound numbers are considered to be Master numbers, the 11/2 and 22/4 because they are more electrical in nature and have a higher energy frequency associated with those numbers versus numbers that do not vibrate to that accelerated level. The others are 19/1, 13/4, 14/5, 23/5, 16/7 and 18/9, all of which have a more intensified meaning because they are a compound number versus being a single-digit number.

The first number in a compound number is considered to be more "influential" because it is the most dominant of the three numbers. The second number supports, accents, or creates an underlying vibrational pattern in which the "first" number operates and is the driving force. At the center of each compound number is the "root" number, derived by adding the two numbers together, e.g.  $11/2 = 1+1$  to get a single "root" number of 2. The vibrational patterns of this "root" number set the "tone" for the compound number's overall impact on what the vibration brings.



Parents now have the power to influence their baby's personality traits by combining modern computer technology, mathematics, and a science of numbers dating back to 6000 B.C. Through the use of our state-of-the-art software computer program, Numbers R U is able to provide you with accurate charts, insight, clarity and understanding of the design of your baby by analyzing his/her blueprint so you will have a thorough understanding of what your child's behavior patterns will be.

Numerology is a very exacting and intricate science, just as astrological charts with their symbols and terminations are complicated. Every chart is customized based on running a name, or name and birthdate you enter into our program.
