Chord Numerology Master Chart for Pets and Animal Naming

The chord or vibration of the name you selected is made up of the following three positions with the assigned number each calculates to be.

Soul Desire = 19/1

Personality = 22/4

Purpose = 5

Following is general information on choosing a chord for your animal's name in addition to an explanation of what each position number means that is personalized to the name you selected. This information will allow you to determine whether you have chosen a "winning" vibration or not.



Naming Your Pets and Animals

General Information on Selecting a Chord or Vibration

The name you give your pets and all your animals forms a unique numerical blueprint for each of their lives. The “chosen” name can influence the vibration of your animal in a positive or negative way.

It has been recognized throughout time that names play a vital part in directing and influencing one’s destiny. Everything and everyone is named and numbered; therefore, Numerology recognizes that a spiritual master plan lay hidden in the numbers of the names comprising them. Numerology applies numerical values to names that determine the experiences drawn to that entity bearing a particular name, whether it’s a pet, a human or a business venture.

For pet lovers, you may simply want to know what the vibration is for the name you have picked for your animal—everyone wants their pets to lead a happy and fulfilled life. Numerology gives you the ability to test how a name affects your pet before you make a final decision.

If you are naming animals associated with a business, such as racehorses, you would probably want to select a name with as “successful” a vibration as possible. Numbers R U allows you to test possible names and variations of spelling for names. For example, the chord of the name “Violet,” calculates to be a 13/4, which is remarkably different than the chord for “Violette,” an 18/9.

It should also be mentioned that the vibration of the name is affected by how the animal is treated. The environment, care, and training all combined shape the overall influence of the animal. As in the case of a racehorse, you may have the most successful vibration from a naming standpoint but if the horse is mishandled or abused, breaking its “will” or “spirit,” will have compromised the full potential of influence the name offered the animal. Loving care for all animals is as important as having a “winning” vibration.

The chord or vibration of a name is made up of three positions or missions: Soul Desire, Personality, and Purpose. The Soul Desire reflects the emotional aspect and inner motivation, the Personality forms the first real impressions made, and the Purpose reveals what the entity’s mission in life will be. Following is an explanation of the number combinations that will bring a successful vibration over those less desirable vibrational patterns. This general information on number combinations will allow you to check the chord of the name you have chosen to see whether the vibration is a good one or not. Some charts include what is termed “compound numbers” such as 22/4. We include those compound numbers because they wield a subtle influence over the chart that is different from the single digit value [4]. Compound numbers that appear on the chart have a more in-depth meaning. Two of the eight most common compound numbers are among what is called Master numbers, the 11/2 and 22/4. The

others are 19/1, 13/4, 14/5, 23/5, 16/7, and 18/9, all of which have a more intensified meaning because they are a compound number versus being a single digit.

The first number in a compound number is considered to be more “influential” and the most dominant of the three numbers. The second number supports, accents, or creates an underlying vibrational pattern in which the “first” number operates and is the driving force. At the center of each compound number is the “root” number, derived by adding the two numbers together, e.g., $11/2 = 1+1$ to get a single “root” number of 2. The chord or vibrational patterns of this “root” number set the “tone” for the compound number’s overall impact on what the vibration brings.

The following table outlines the numbers that are not usually considered to form a successful vibration in any combination for the three numbers that make up the chord of the name you chose. If any of the numbers listed below, 14/5, 7, or 16/7, appear in the Chord chart, you will know that the name selected is not the best choice possible based on the vibration the chord brings. Perhaps the name you picked is not the “right” one. If so, come up with more names until you find the right chord that brings a “winning” vibration.

The table below shows the most favorable compound and single-digit numbers that can be used in any number combination to form a successful vibration for the three numbers that make up the chord.

19/1 * 11/2 * 23/5 * 18/9 * 1 * 3 * 5 * 8 * 9
“Favorable Numbers”

The favorable numbers can create many “vibrational” pattern combinations that will bring varying degrees of good chords, as each number is associated with a very specific meaning that it represents. Although there are many good number combinations, you may decide that you want the most successful vibration available that comes from this mix of numbers. For business reasons, we suggest that anyone wanting a more specific explanation of the chord they chose to order a written or live consultation.



What the Chord Numbers Mean–Soul Desire, Personality and Purpose

Following is a brief written explanation of the meaning of the numbers, which may appear in any of the three positions that make up the “chord” or vibration of name you selected for your animal. The three numbers outlined in the chart are unique only to the name you have selected. If you select another name, you will most likely get a different result. The descriptions are written to explain the meaning on an ideal level, and then you need to apply that meaning to how it will relate to your pets.

The #19/1 Soul Desire (Also called Heart’s Desire)

This is the emotional aspect and is the innermost desire to seek to express itself in this world. The #1 Soul Desire brings with it all of the characteristics of a leader, individual, and pioneer.

The #22/4 Personality (Master Number)

The Personality is the physical aspect of the entity. The #4 Personality gives the impression of being conservative, orderly, and self-reliant.

The #22/4 is a Master number that raises the root #4 to a much higher energy level. The “twos” bring emotional energy, tact, detail, and diplomacy to the vibration. The root #4 adds discipline, structure, foundation, and a less emotional aspect. This is the number of the master builder. The #22 Master number represents the intensity of the #4.

The #5 Purpose

The Purpose number reveals what your mission in life will be. The #5 Purpose in life is to promote freedom. This involves bringing forth new ideas for the purpose of expansion and progress to pass these concepts on to others.
